June 2015, the weekend of her 3rd birthday Athena was diagnosed with Pre-B ALL Leukemia. Her life turned from cartoons and toys, to needles, blood draws and chemo. Instead of running around playing on playgrounds she was running around the halls of a hospital while being connected to an IV pole.

In the 2 and a half years of treatment Athena endured 17 spinal tips, countless blood transfusions, her loss, joint and nerve pain, blood draws, hospital stays and so much more that a child should not have to endure.

On August 17, 2015 Athena took her last chemo pill and she became a **SURVIVOR** beating cancer!!



EVERY 2 minutes a child is diagnosed with cancer.

More than 40,000 children are in cancer treatment each year. More than 15,000 children & teens will be diagnosed this year in the U.S.

95% of kids who win the fight against cancer, have other lifelong side effects from the cancer and/or its treatment.

Since 1980, ONLY 3 drugs have been specifically approved & less than 10 drugs have been developed for use in children.

4% of government cancer research goes to childhood cancer.
